

original razer blade windows a upgrade Instructions

Windows 8 Upgrade Disclaimer:

Please note after updating to Windows 8 your Blade will not be able to use its internal recovery partition to down grade back to Windows 7, if you would like to go back to Windows 7 please contact Razer Blade support for recovery media.

It is recommended to <u>back up all your data</u> to an external media before attempting any software upgrade.

Please follow the 7 Steps below to upgrade your Original Blade to Windows 8.

Step 1: Purchase and Download the Windows 8 Upgrade.

Step 2: Download and Run the latest firmware update to your Razer Blade at <u>www.razersupport.com/downloads</u> or by clicking the hyper link below. <u>Firmware updater</u>

Step 3: Before starting the upgrade please un-install the following applications and drivers and restart your Blade when prompted to do so.

- FinTek USB Driver
- Dolby Home Theater v4
- Microsoft Security Essential's
- All Intel PROSet applications \ Drivers
- All Nvidia applications \ Drivers (Graphics Driver, HD Audio Driver, PhysX System Software)

Step 4: Start the Windows 8 **Upgrade** from the file that was downloaded earlier from Microsoft. This file will give you the ability to run the upgrade from your computer, make a Bootable USB disk (USB Flash drive required) or make a Bootable DVD (Blank DVD, external optical drive required). The following steps will be the same for all methods.




Step 5: Click Install Now. And follow the on screen prompts. (Pictures below)





Step 6: At this point Windows 8 is upgrading your Blade and your Blade will restart several times during this process. This can take up to an hour for the upgrade to complete.

Step 7: Welcome back to Windows. Please download and install the updated Windows 8 Drivers* and Razer Synapse. You can find the drivers at the hyperlinks below or also at <u>www.razersupport.com/downloads</u>.
