

4. USING YOUR RAZER MORAY*

ACHIEVE PROPER SEAL

To enjoy the full-bodied bass of the Razer Moray as it is intended, please ensure that the earphones are properly fitted into your ears and that a proper seal is achieved to block out ambient noise.

REMOVING YOUR RAZER MORAY*

CAUTION: Do not yank out earphones from your ears as the sudden release of air pressure might cause potential discomfort.

EAR-BUD SIZES


Due to the different ear canal sizes of individuals, the default ear-buds may not achieve a proper seal. Interchanging the ear-buds to a larger/smaller size will improve performance.


REMOVING THE EAR-BUDS

- 1. Firmly hold the neck of the earphone.
- 2. Grip the opening of the ear-bud firmly with the other hand.
- 3. Pull ear-bud downwards gently until it is released from tip of the earphones.

REPLACING THE EAR-BUDS

- 1. Firmly hold the neck of the earphone.
- 2. Push mouth of the ear-bud onto tip of the earphone.
- 3. As you apply pressure, use a gentle twisting motion until ear-bud is secured and in place.





5. SAFFTY AND MAINTENANCE

SAFETY GUIDELINES

In order to achieve maximum safety while using your Razer Moray^t, we suggest that you adopt the following guidelines:

- 1. Should you have trouble operating the device properly and troubleshooting does not work, unplug the device and contact the Razer hotline or go to www.razersupport.com for support. Do not attempt to service or fix the device yourself at any time.
- 2. Do not take apart the device (doing so will void your warranty) and do not attempt to operate it under abnormal current loads.
- 3. Keep the device away from liquid, humidity or moisture. Operate the device only within the specific temperature range of 0°C (32°F) to 40°C (104°F). Should the temperature exceed this range, unplug and switch off the device in order to let the temperature stabilize within the optimal temperature range.
- 4. The Razer Moray isolates external ambient sounds even at low volumes, resulting in lowered awareness of your external surroundings. Please remove the Razer Moray when engaging in any activity that requires active awareness of your surroundings.
- 5. Listening to excessively loud volumes over extended periods of time can damage your hearing. Furthermore, legislation of certain countries permits a maximum sound level of 86db to affect your hearing for 8 hours a day. We therefore recommend that you reduce the volume to a comfortable level when listening for prolonged periods of time. Please, take good care of your hearing.

MAINTENANCE AND USE

The Razer Moray requires minimum maintenance to keep it in optimum condition. Once a month we recommend you unplug the device from the USB port and clean it using a soft cloth or cotton swab with a bit of warm water to prevent dirt buildup. Do not use soap or harsh cleaning
