Please follow the instructions below to download and install the original driver for your Blade. Following the installation, it is recommended to search for any available Windows Updates.

- Ensure your Blade is plugged into a wall outlet and not running on battery alone before proceeding.
- Please save any open documents on your computer and close all other programs before attempting this update.
- Download the driver from the link below. You will need to right click the .zip folder and choose to extract the files to a location of your choosing (such as your desktop) to locate the files for the installation process.

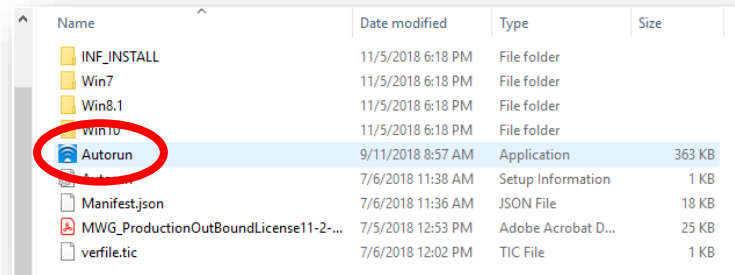

- Once you have extracted the file proceed to the installation steps below.

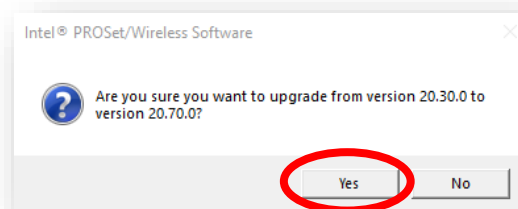

## INSTALLATION PROCESS

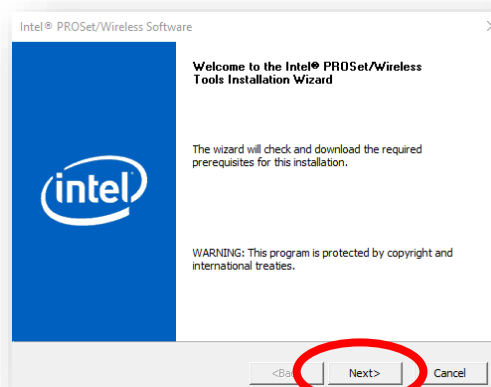
1. To begin the installation process, click on the Autorun.exe (application) as shown below:



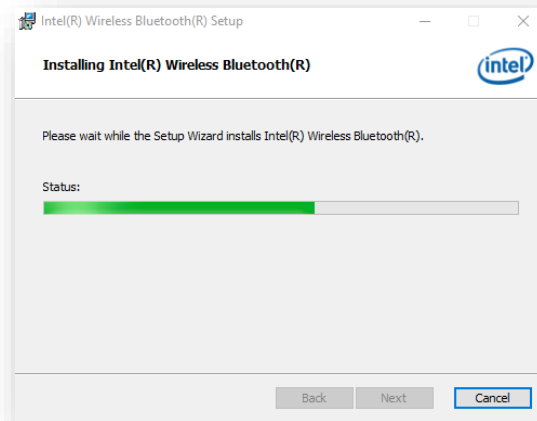
2. When prompted by User Account Control, click 'Yes' to confirm the changes to be made to your system.



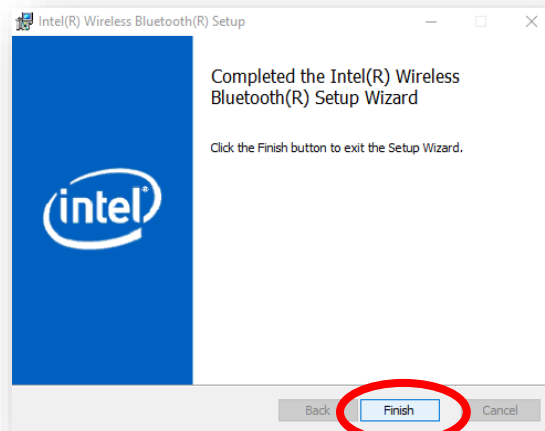
3. You will be prompted then by a dialogue box that will ask if you wish to upgrade from your current version to the available upgradable version (as shown above). Click 'Yes' to begin the install process, which will follow with a new dialogue box:



4. Click Next > Next > Check the box to accept the License Agreement then click Next > Then choose Typical as your setup type. Then click 'Install'. A progress bar will appear with an approximation on time remaining until the install is complete:
