





4. SETTING UP YOUR CONTROLLER


Before connecting the Razer Raion to your PC or PS4™, set the Mode switch to the corresponding system (PC or PS4) you'll be using it with. Once connected, the status indicator will turn solid green.

As a safety feature for your gameplay, any mode will only be applied when you unplug and reconnect the controller.



On PS4™

Press the PS button to begin using the controller.



On PC

Wait until its drivers are automatically installed or manually update them through the Device Manager.



5. USING THE RAZER RAION


MUTING MICROPHONE INPUT

Press the Mic mute button to mute or unmute microphone input from the connected headset.



ADJUSTING THE VOLUME

Press the Volume control button to cycle through the volume levels of the Stereo headset port. You may also press and hold the Volume control button, and then press the up or down buttons of the D-pad to increase or decrease the audio volume of the Stereo headset port respectively. You will hear a notification tone when the Stereo headset port volume reaches its lowest or highest setting.




USING THE D-PAD MODE SWITCH

Use the D-pad mode switch to shift the controller function to either directional pad (DP), left analog stick (LS), or right analog stick (RS).




ACTIVATING COMPETITION MODE

Press the Mic mute and Volume control buttons simultaneously while in-game to activate Competition Mode. The status indicator will turn solid white, indicating that the mode is active. Under this mode, the PS, SHARE, and OPTIONS buttons are disabled.




CHANGING BUMPER MODES

By default, the left bumpers are set to L1 / L2 and the right bumpers are set to R1 / R2.



If your game requires the L3 and R3 analog stick buttons, set the Bumper mode switch to **L3-L1/R3-L2**. This will set the left bumpers to L3/R3, and the L1/L2 replacing the right bumpers.



6. SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE

SAFETY GUIDELINES

In order to achieve maximum safety while using your Razer Raion, we suggest that you adopt the following guidelines:

Should you have trouble operating the device properly and troubleshooting does not work, unplug the device and contact the Razer hotline or go to <u>support.razer.com</u> for assistance.

Do not take apart the device (doing so will void your warranty) and do not attempt to operate it under abnormal current loads.

Keep the device away from liquid, humidity or moisture. Operate the device only within the specific temperature range of 0°C (32°F) to 40°C (104°F). Should the temperature exceed this range, unplug the device in order to let the temperature stabilize to an optimal level.

MAINTENANCE AND USE

The Razer Raion requires minimum maintenance to keep it in optimum condition. Once a month we recommend you unplug the device and clean it using a soft cloth or cotton swab to prevent dirt buildup. Do not use soap or harsh cleaning agents.

Do not clean the Razer Raion with alcohol-based solutions or other solvents. Doing so may tarnish the exterior surface of the controller.
