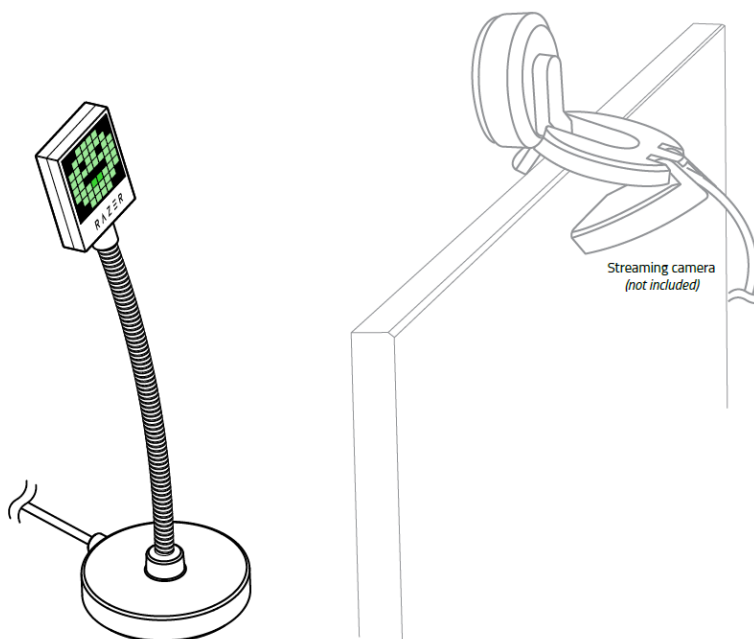
4. SETTING UP YOUR RAZER EMOTE DISPLAY

1. Connect the Razer Emote Display to your PC*.



**Install Razer Synapse when prompted or download the installer from [razer.com/synapse](https://www.razer.com/synapse). Make sure to include the Chroma Connect module or install it from Razer Synapse.*

2. Position the lighting of the Razer Emote Display towards your streaming camera (not included) and adjust the gooseneck stand as needed.



3. Download the Streamer Companion App from [razer.com/streamer-companion-app](https://www.razer.com/streamer-companion-app) to begin customizing audience interactions for your device and more.

5. SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE

SAFETY GUIDELINES

In order to achieve maximum safety while using your Razer Abyssus Lite, we suggest that you adopt the following guidelines:

Should you have trouble operating the device properly and troubleshooting does not work, unplug the device and contact the Razer hotline or go to support.razer.com for support.

Do not take apart the device (doing so will void your warranty) and do not attempt to operate it under abnormal current loads.

Keep the device away from liquid, humidity or moisture. Operate the device only within the specific temperature range of 0°C (32°F) to 40°C (104°F). Should the temperature exceed this range, unplug and/or switch off the device in order to let the temperature stabilize to an optimal level.

Avoid looking directly at the tracking beam of your mouse or pointing the beam in anyone else's eye. Note that the tracking beam is NOT visible to the naked human eye and is set on an Always-On mode.

MAINTENANCE AND USE

The Razer Emote Display requires minimum maintenance to keep it in optimum condition. Once a month we recommend you unplug the device from the computer and clean it using a soft cloth or cotton to prevent dirt buildup. Don't use soap or harsh cleaning agents.
